What will you achieve at each level?

A1 - Basic 1 to 2 - 80 hours

- + You can introduce yourself and others (nationality, age, family...), express your likes and dislikes, talk about your activities, manage simple purchasing situations, ask for directions and find your way around a place.
- + Upon completion of the A1 level, you can have a basic conversation in French.

A2 - Intermediate 1 to 3 - 120 hours

- + You can now use past, present and future tenses! This enables you to talk about past events and plan for future activities. Your command of grammar and vocabulary allows you to face most usual situations.
- + Upon completion of level A2, you can live in a French-speaking country.

B1 - Independent 1 to 6 - 240hrs

- + You have very strong basic French and are capable of facing any situation. You can make hypotheses and suppositions on events that might occur and express different realities (conditional or subjunctive). You can give your opinion and convince others. Your vocabulary covers a wide range of topics.
- + Upon completion of level B1, you can join a few university programs in France or apply for French citizenship if you are married to a French citizen.

B2 - Advanced 1 to 6 - 240hrs

- + You can express yourself fluently and spontaneously and have a normal conversation with a native speaker without much effort. You can communicate clearly and in details on various topics, give your opinion on current affairs and present pros and cons arguments in various situations.
- + Upon completion of level B2, you can apply for a master's degree in a French university or get extra precious points for your immigration file to Québec and Canada.

C1 - Proficient C1

- + You are now a specialist and the language holds almost no secrets for you! You can adapt it to your social, professional or academic life and use it efficiently.
- + You can apply for most of the higher university programs in France such as PhDs or get more extra precious points for your immigration file to Québec and Canada.

C2 - Proficient C2

- + You are now a specialist and the language holds no secrets for you! You can adapt it to your social, professional or academic life and use it efficiently.
- + You can become a translator or interpreter or work effectively in international organizations (i.e. : UNO, WHO...).
